Intake & Forms

This information stays with us and is not shared with anyone. We do share some info like gender, ethnicity, and age with our grant funders for statistical reporting, but never any personal information.

Please be sure to bring your ID with you to the intake appointment!



Online Tutor Training

We ask that all potential tutors complete the online tutor training provided by ProLiteracy® or Illinois Secretary of State (ILSOS). We can provide more information and instruction for whichever training you decide. After training is completed, we will set up a time for you to come to the office for additional program orientation.



Learner Matching

When you feel ready to accept a learner our team will make the match! Be patient, sometimes we have learners on deck. Other times, we are waiting for learners. If you find that you are waiting, our office is your home! Feel free to borrow some of our materials, or we may even be able to arrange shadowing with other matches.
